Local Attractions

Surry is Something Special

- Bacon's Castle Museum (Route 10 east of park at Bacon's Castle)
- Smith's Fort Plantation (Route 31, approximately 2 miles north of Surry)
- Edwards Virginia Hams & Gift Shop
- Surry Nuclear Power Station Visitor Center (turn left at Bacon's Castle and follow the signs)
- Hog Island Wildlife Preserve (travel past the Surry Power Station to refuge entrance)

Ferry:

The Jamestown – Scotland ferry is toll free and runs approximately every half-hour during the summer months. A ferry schedule may be obtained at the park office. Directions to the ferry from the park: Turn right at the park entrance, and travel 1 mile, turning right onto Rt 637 (Popular Lawn Road). Follow Popular Lawn to the end and turn right onto Rt 636 (Cobham Wharf) approximately 2.5 miles to Rt 31 and turn right to ferry landing.
