## Recycling Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs



By replacing incandescent bulbs with compact Fluorescent light bulbs (CFL's) residents can reduce their energy consumption, reduce pollution and save money. CFL's use 75% less energy and last up to 10 times longer than incandescent bulbs. Since they produce about 70% less heat, their use can result in lower cooling costs during warmer months.

CFL's are safe to use in your home or business in spite of the fact that they contain about 5mg of mercury. However, when disposing of CFL bulbs, one does need to be cautious. If a CFL breaks, the mercury contained in its tubing can be released into the environment.

While Surry County does not currently provide for the recycling of CFL's, area home improvement stores will recycle unbroken CFL bulbs free of charge for residents in their service area. Check with the home improvement stores in your area.



# Recycling in Surry County

All of these items can be recycled:



Cardboard Boxes  
(Must be flattened)



Mixed Papers  
(including junk mail and newspapers)



#1 and #2 Plastic Bottles and Containers  
(Must be rinsed clean)  
(Do not include bottle caps)



Steel, Tin and Aluminum Cans  
(Must be rinsed clean)



Glass Bottles and Jars  
(Must be rinsed clean)

Recyclable materials can be deposited into one container at Goodson Path and Pineview Waste Collection Sites:  
**sorting is not necessary!**

## **DO NOT RECYCLE:**

- AEROSOL CANS
- PAINT CANS
- PLASTIC BAGS
- WOOD PRODUCTS
- YARD OR ORGANIC WASTE

## Recycling Tires

County residents can bring automobile tires to the Goodson Path site for recycling.

- Tires must be off the rims
- No tractor tires will be accepted
- Attendants may not accept more than 4 tires per day per residence

Goodwill Industries has placed a container box at all three manned Convenience Sites where citizens are encouraged to contribute reusable clothing and shoes.

## Recycling Scrap Metal

Scrap metal is accepted at Goodson Path and Pineview Solid Waste Collection sites. Site attendants will determine which items are acceptable for recycling.
